

# Circumflex

- Runs in left coronary sulcus
  - **Obtuse marginal branches** to lateral left ventricle (numbered as they arise from LCX)
- Obtuse marginals (M1, M2...), because they supply the lateral *margin* of the left ventricle and branch off with an *obtuse* angle.
- Cx ends as an obtuse marginal branch, but 10% of patients have a left dominant circulation in which the Cx also supplies the posterior descending artery (PDA).
- Mnemonic: **M**arginal branches arise from the Cx and supply the lateral **M**argin of the left ventricle
