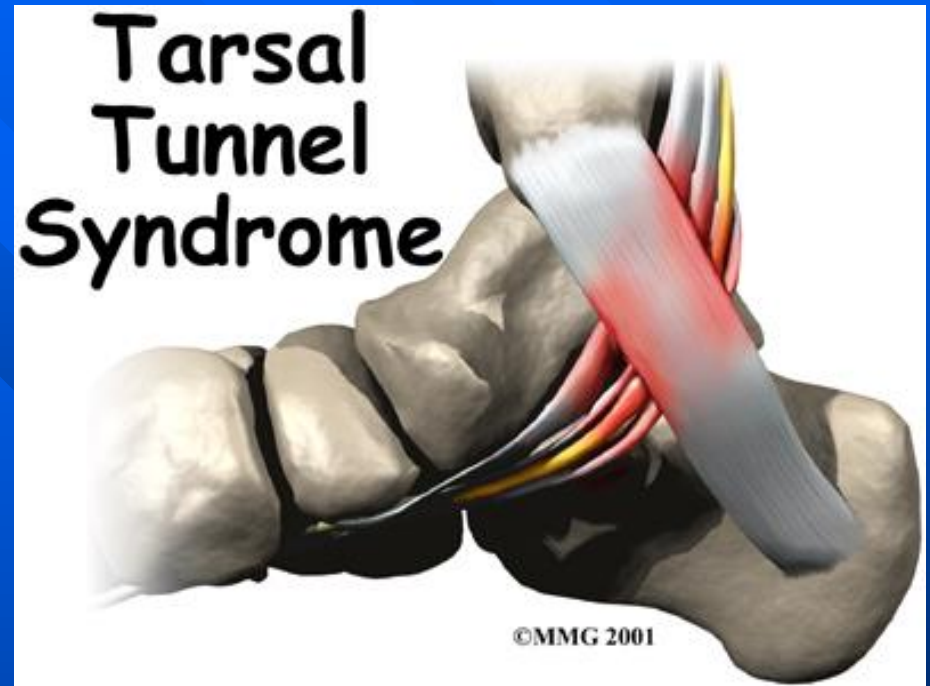
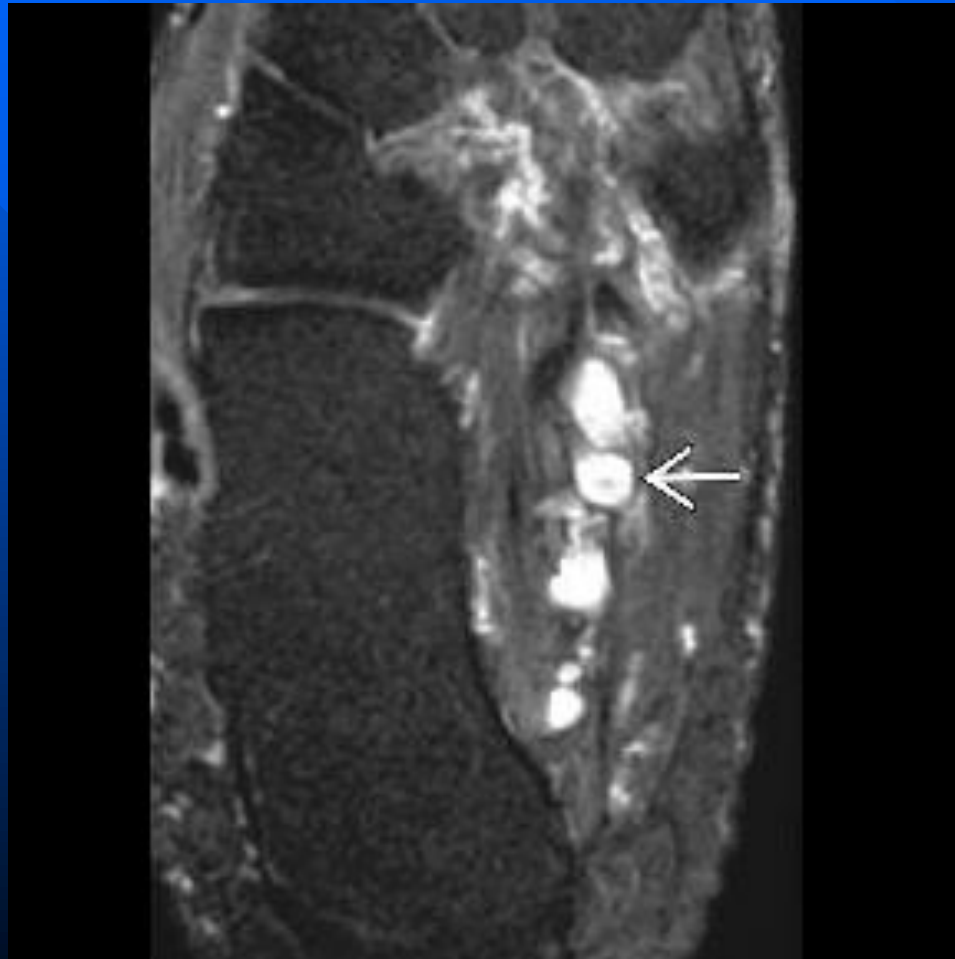


Tarsal Tunnel Syndrome

- vague pain in the sole of the foot (burning or tingling sensation)
- Compression of posterior tibial nerve or branches
- Ganglion and nerve sheath tumors, many other causes,
- Give contrast to differentiate



Hyperintense varicosities (arrow) within the tarsal tunnel



Edema pattern suggests denervation
from the ganglion pressing on the
posterior tibial nerve

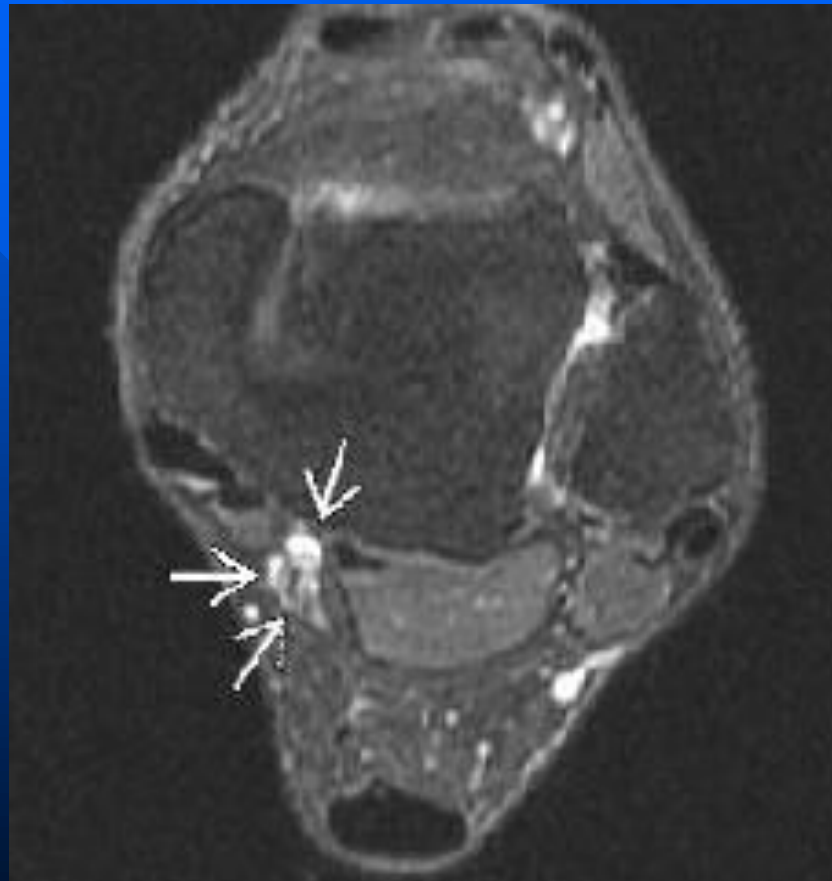


Coronal T2WI FS MR
