
## Sinus Tarsi Syndrome

- Cone between talus and calcaneus
- Small end of cone is medially, large end is laterally
- Lateral foot pain
- □ 70% related to trauma
- Usually tears of the Anterior talofibular ligament and Calcaneofibular ligament.
- Obliteration of Fat, dark on T1 bright or dark on T2
- Diagnosis not made in the setting of acute trauma, may be abnormal due to blood or edema from joint


## Sinus Tarsi






Sinus Tarsi and its contents are located between the calcaneus and talus
