

Reverse Bankart

- Defined as the detachment of postero inferior labrum with avulsion of posterior capsular periosteum.
- This leads to laxity of posterior band of the inferior glenohumeral ligament with posterior displacement of the humerus head.

Pathology

- Repetitive trauma
- Posterior dislocation
- Hypoplastic glenoid, glenoid retroversion
- Fall on outstretched hand: Posterosuperior labral tear
