

Volar Perilunar dislocation



"crowded carpal" sign
specific for volar perilunate dislocation. It is secondary to proximal migration of the distal row of carpal bones during subluxation.

Perilunate Dislocation



Very commonly associated with a scaphoid waist fracture

Sometimes ulnar styloid as well

Lunate appears triangular in shape on frontal view

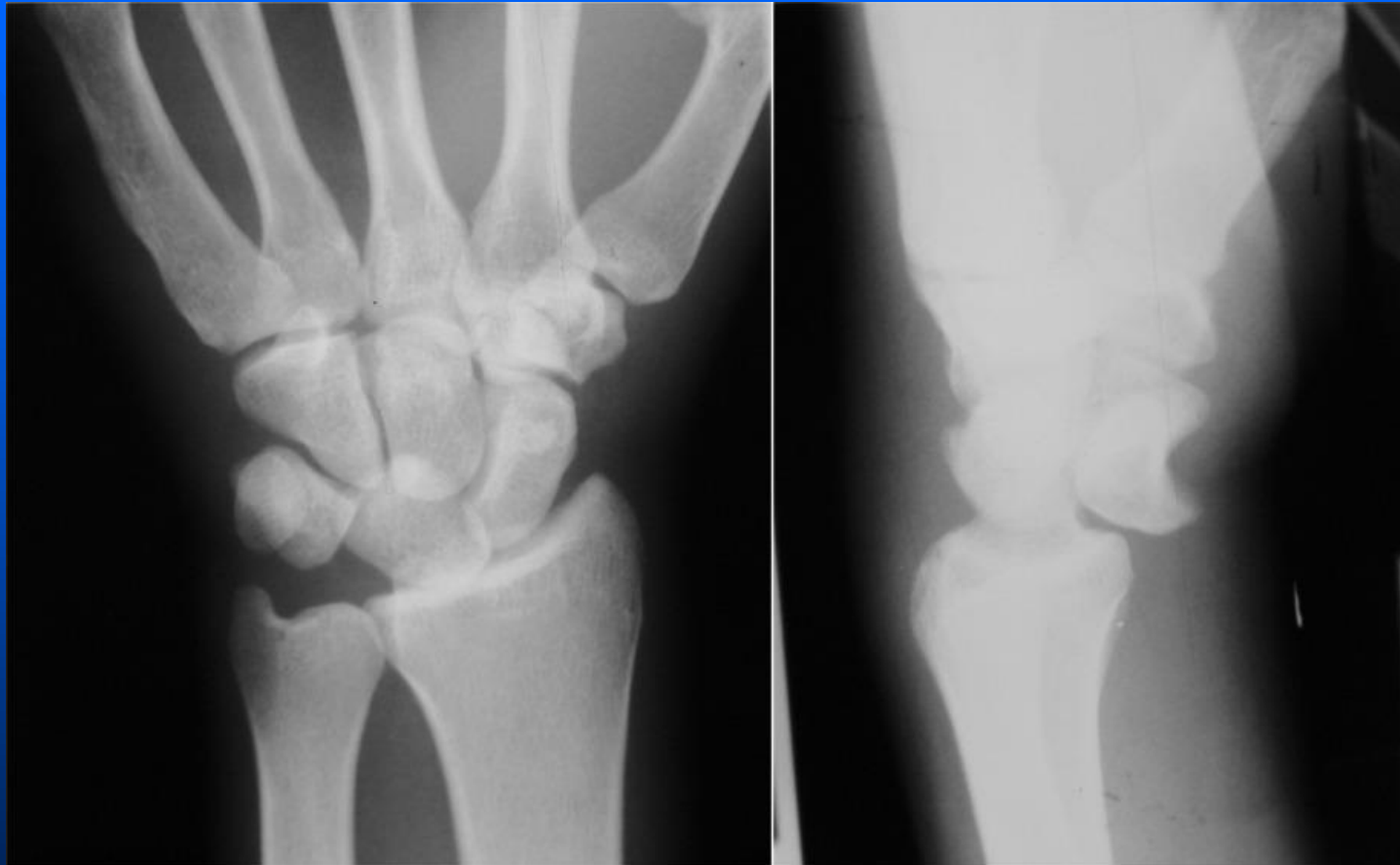
Dorsal perilunate dislocation

Most severe of carpal instabilities, Triangular appearance of lunate on frontal projection
