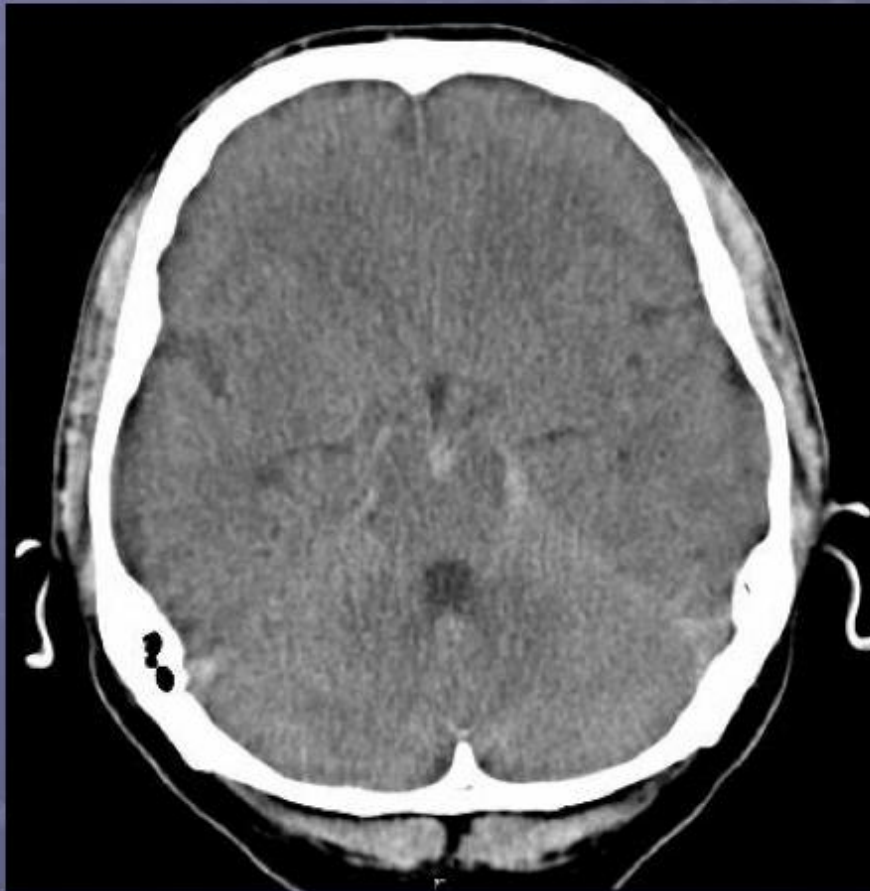


Perimesencephalic Subarachnoid Hemorrhage



- Represents approximately 10% of all cases of SAH.
- Blood is typically found in the cisterns around the midbrain and anterior to the pons, without extension to the sylvian or interhemispheric fissures.
- Prognosis in these patients is excellent, even without therapy.

Perimesencephalic subarachnoid hemorrhage

- Often involves interpeduncular, ambient, quadrigeminal cisterns
- $\pm$ thin extension into posterior suprasellar, proximal sylvian/interhemispheric fissures
- Does not extend into distal sylvian, interhemispheric fissures
- No vasospasm
