

Salivary Glands

- Parotid
 - Stenson's duct
- Submandibular gland
 - Wharton's duct
- Sublingual
 - Ducts of Rivinus
- Minor Salivary Glands

Salivary Lesions

- Cysts - lymphoepithelial, branchial
- Sialadenitis
- Pleomorphic Adenoma
- Warthins Tumor
- Adenoid Cystic – cylindroma
- Mucoepidermoid

Minor Salivary Glands

- All over aerodigestive tract (pharynx, larynx, sinuses)
- Most numerous in oral cavity (palate)
- No ducts
- Source of mucus retention cysts

Palpable Mass

- Larger the gland lower the likelihood a mass will be malignant (adults)
 - Cannot tell benign vs. malignant
- Parotid 15% - Mucoepidermoid
- SMG 50% - Adenoid Cystic
- SL/ MSG 70% - Adenoid Cystic
