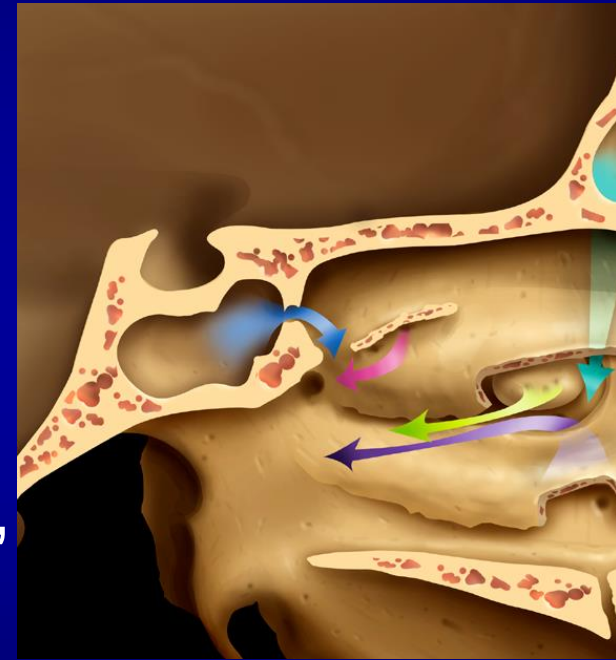


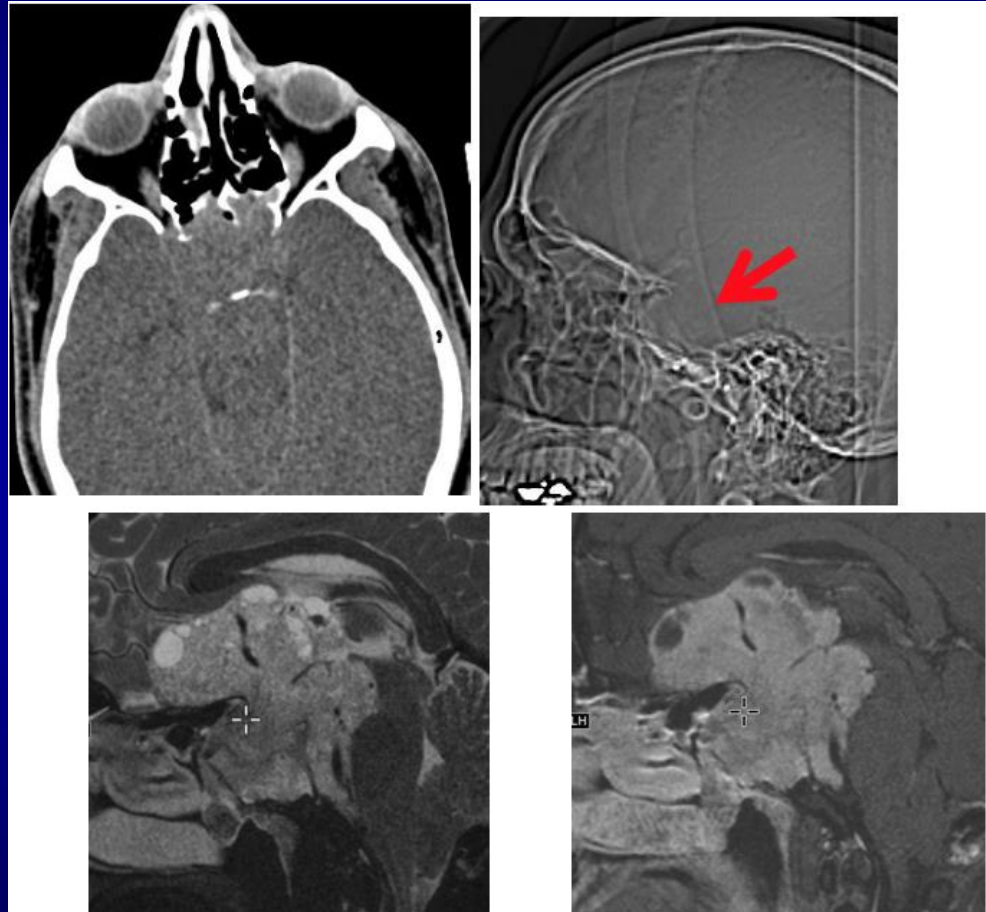
Sphenoid sinus

- Extremely variable pneumatization
- Dev. complete by 2nd decade
- Planum sphenoidale, posterior wall, anterior wall, inferolateral & pterygoid recesses
- Ant. wall is roof of nasopharynx
- Rarely non-pneumatized normally, consider anemia or cystic fibrosis
- Sphenoethmoidal recess



Sphenoid Sinus

- Rarely sinonasal tumor
- Adjacent process
 - Fungal Sinusitis
 - Pituitary adenoma
 - Clival/skull base lesion
