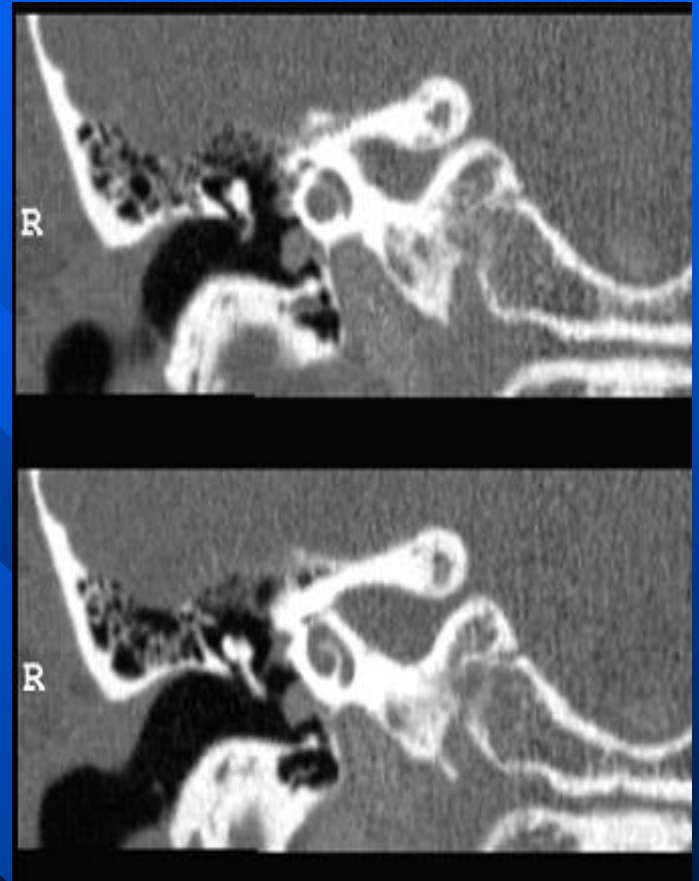
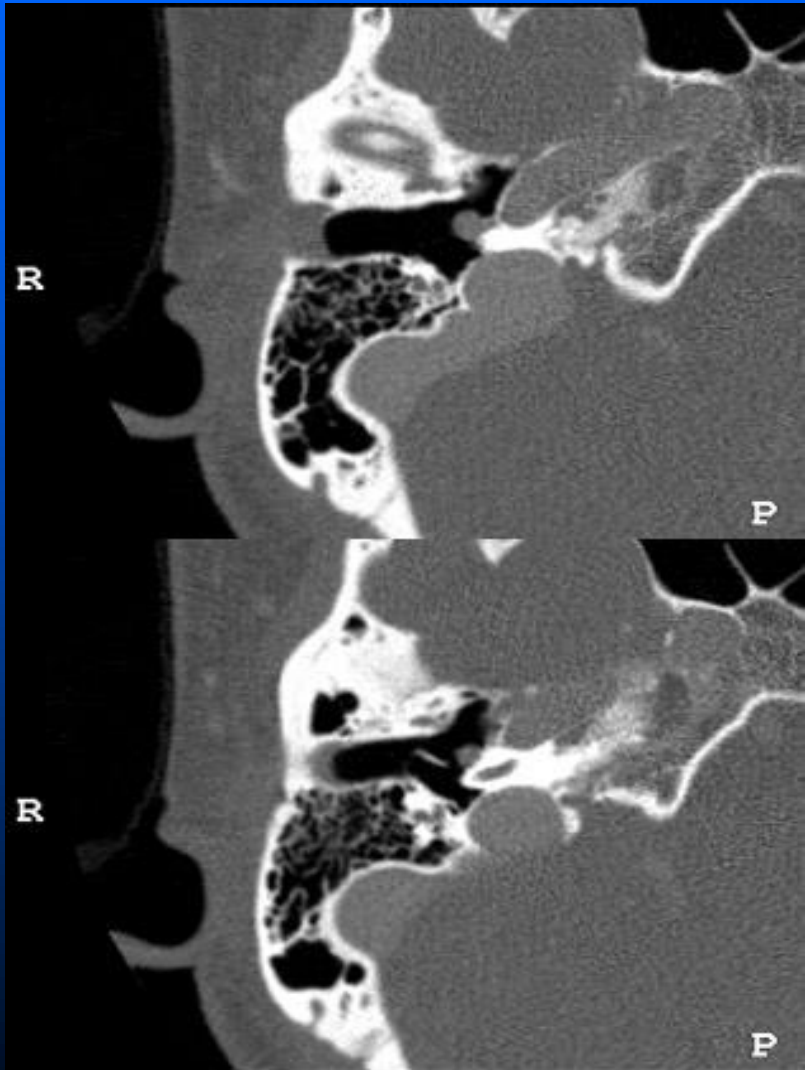


Glomus tympanicum

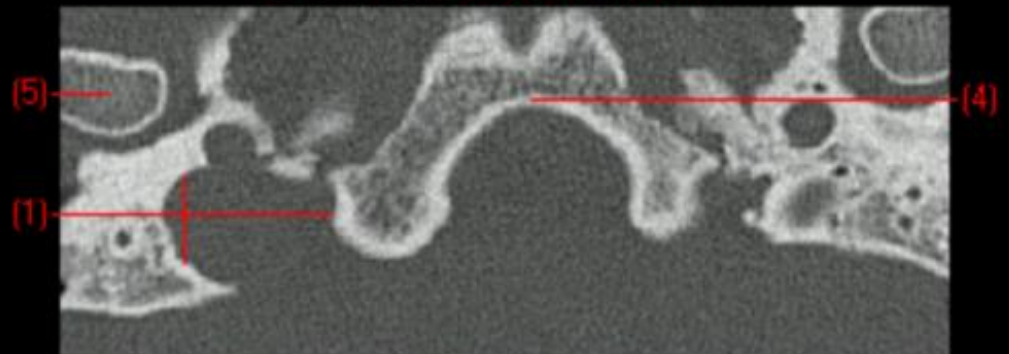


CT images :

variant.

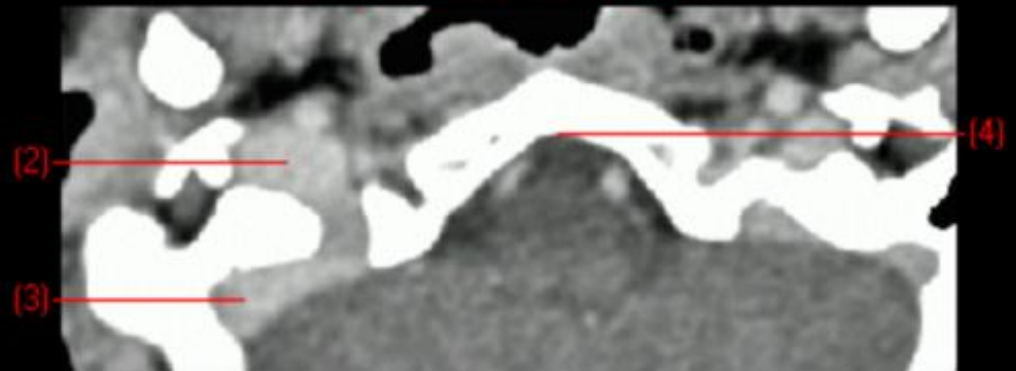
- (1) Enlarged jugular foramen

pusatile tinnitus

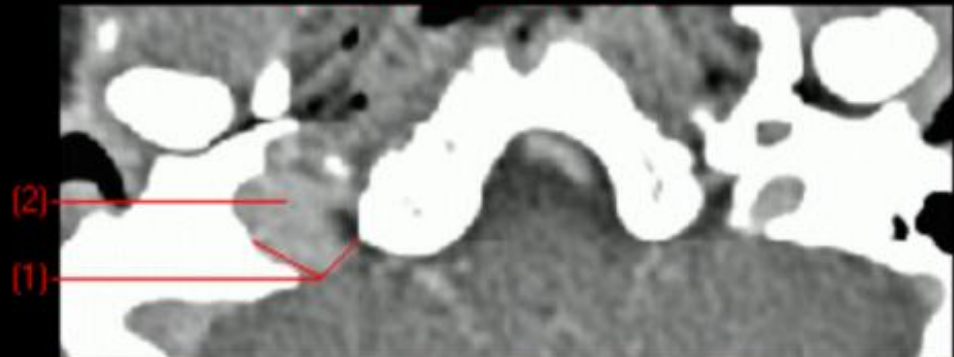
CT transverse C-S, bone window

- Paraganglioma
- Pulsatile tinnitus
- Middle ear mass on cochlear promontory
- Enhances with Gd+
- Jugular, vagale, tympanicum, carotid body tumor
