HIV vacuolar myelopathy

- Most common chronic myelopathy associated with <u>HIV infection</u>
- Typically seen in the late stages of HIV infection.
- Spinal cord atrophy is the most common finding, typically involving the thoracic cord; cervical cord may also be involved
- Bilateral symmetric dorsal column involvement can be seen: similar to <u>subacute combined degeneration</u>
