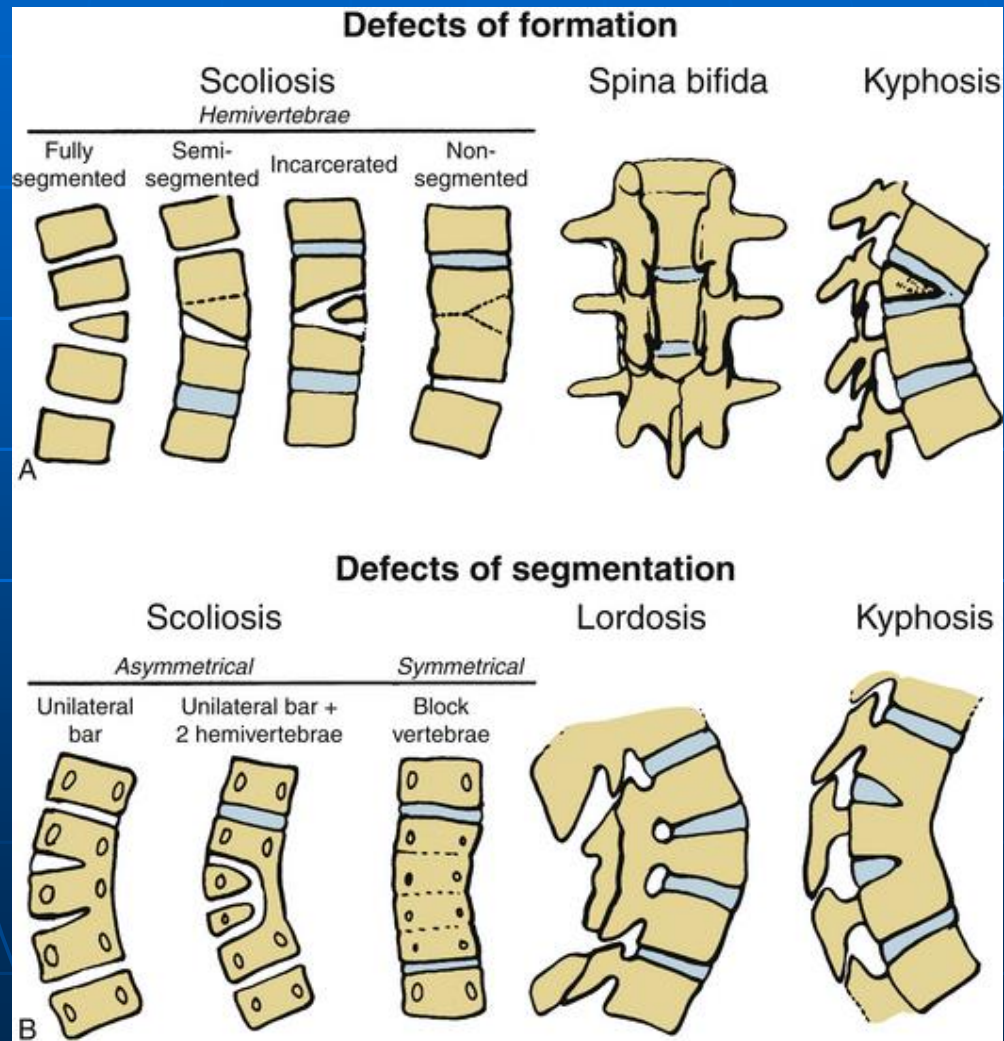

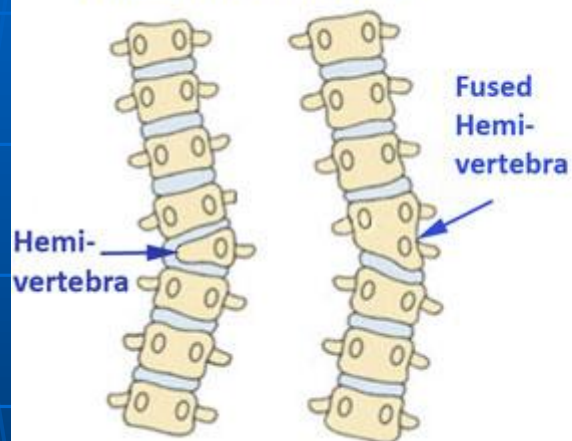

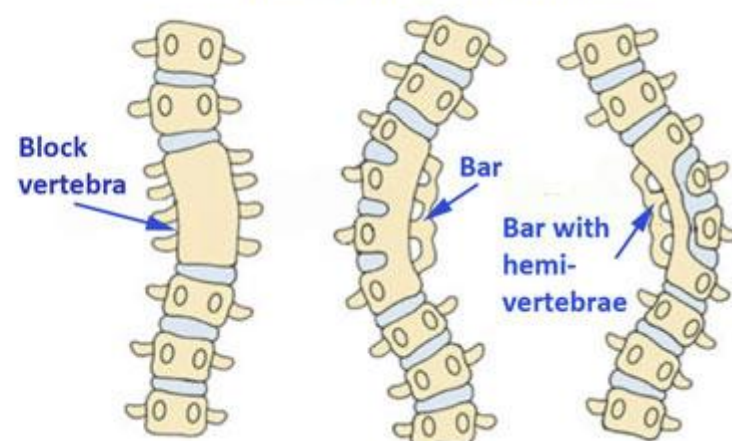


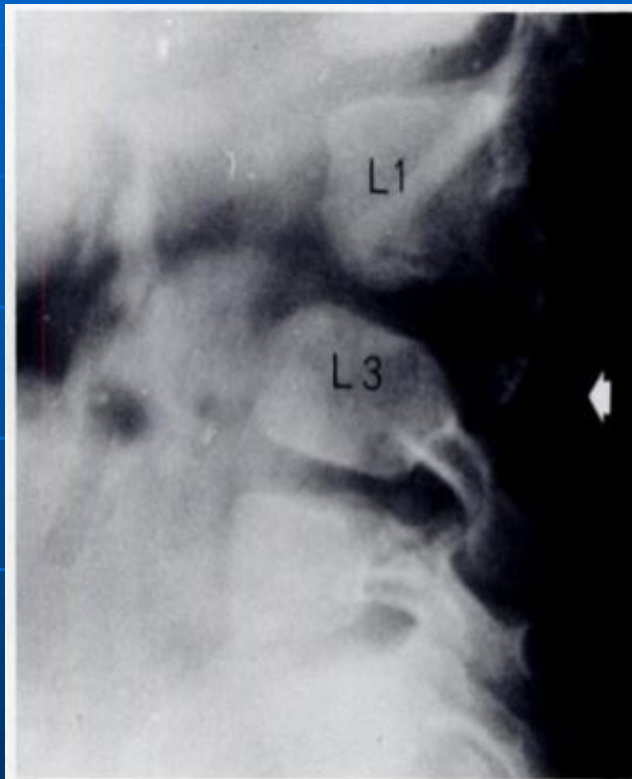

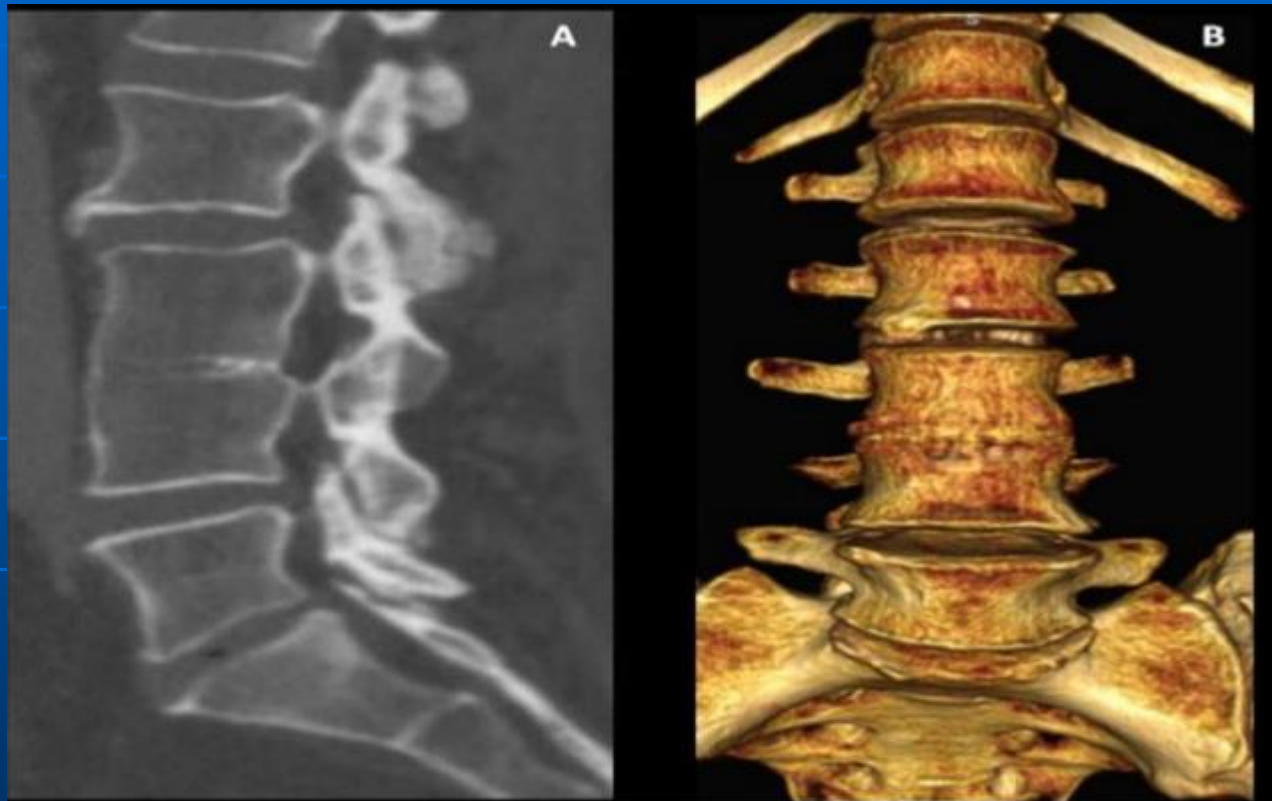
Asomia Congenital absence of the body of L2 Hypoplastic posterior elements are present (arrow).
